### **ORDINANCE NO. 3064**

#### **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE I, GOVERNMENT CODE, CHAPTER 105: ADMINISTRATION, SECTION 105.320: EMPLOYEE BENEFITS CONTRIBUTION FUND, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS.**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Paola, Kansas, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That Section 105.320 is hereby repealed in its entirety and a new Section 105.320 is hereby enacted in its place to read as follows:

#### **SECTION 105.320: EMPLOYEE BENEFITS CONTRIBUTION FUND**

- A. The City of Paola, Kansas, in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 1978 Supp. 12-16,102, does hereby establish an employee benefits contribution fund for the purpose of paying the City's share of employee benefits prescribed by Subsection (B) of this Section.
- B. The City's share of the cost of employee benefits authorized for payment from the fund created by Subsection (A) of this Section shall include the following:
  - 1. Social Security (FICA and Medicare).
  - 2. Kansas Public Employees Retirement System (KPERS).
  - 3. Kansas Police and Firemen's Retirement System (KP&F).
  - 4. Worker's Compensation benefits.
  - 5. Employment Security (unemployment compensation) benefits.
  - 6. Health and wellness, disability, life insurance benefits, and accruals for benefits as required by city personnel policy.

**SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper pursuant to KSA 12-3001, et seq.
