ORDINANCE NO. 3071

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2999

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2999 “AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 10, SECTION 10.1 OF THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS, MORE SPECIFICALLY SECTION 10.1 RELATING TO CRIMINAL USE OF WEAPONS” that was duly adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Paola on the 25th day of August, 2009, (*Codified as Section 205.240: Criminal Use of Weapons of the Code of the City of Paola, Kansas, 2009*) is hereby repealed in its entirety;

SECTION 2. That this ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper pursuant to KSA 12-3001, et seq.
