Action - Motion to approve AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 205.005 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS, 2009, REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES, EDITION OF 2016", WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS. (Ordinance No 3100)

b. Consider Adoption of the 2016 Standard Traffic Ordinance.
