Ordinance No. 3103 Summary

On September 27, 2016, the City of Paola, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 3103, amending Section 125.030, Fees and Charges, in Chapter 125 Cemetery Provisions, of the Code of the City of Paola, Kansas, 2009, by increasing certain fees and charges for various services, permits and the sales price of cemetery positions; and also adding Section 125.035, Cremation Burial Regulations, in Chapter 125 Cemetery Provisions, of the Code of the City of Paola, Kansas, 2009. ORDINANCE NO 3103

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 125.030, FEES AND CHARGES, AND ADDING SECTION 125.035, CREMATION BURIAL REGULATIONS, IN CHAPTER 125, CEMETERY PROVISIONS, OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS, 2009.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Paola, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That Section 125.030. Fees and Charges, in Chapter 125 Cemetery Provisions, of the Code of the City of Paola, Kansas, 2009, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 125.030. Fees and Charges.

A. The following fees and charges shall be made for cemetery services in the Paola Cemetery:

1. Permit for Monuments and Headstones:

Monument:	\$25.00
Headstone:	\$25.00
Government Issued Marker:	\$0.00

2. Disinterment Fees:

Disinterment Permit:	\$100.00
Open and Close:	\$750.00
Relocation in Paola cemetery:	\$300.00

(Disinterment services ONLY during regular business hours, Monday thru Friday.)

3. Open and Close – Mausoleum:	
Weekdays 8 am to 4 pm:	\$200.00
Saturday and weekdays after 4:00 pm:	\$300.00
Sunday & Holidays:	\$330.00
4. Open and Close – Casket and Vault:	
Weekdays 8 am to 4 pm:	\$500.00
Saturday and weekdays after 4:00 pm:	\$600.00
Sunday & Holidays:	\$650.00
5. Open and Close – Cremation:	
Weekdays 8 am to 4 pm:	\$250.00
Saturday and weekdays after 4:00 pm:	\$350.00
Sunday & Holidays:	\$400.00
6. Open and Close – Infant Grave:	
Weekdays 8 am to 4 pm:	\$100.00
Saturday and weekdays after 4:00 pm:	\$200.00
Sunday & Holidays:	\$250.00

B. The following fees shall be made for purchasing cemetery positions in the Paola Cemetery:

<u>Cemetery Addition</u>	<u>Price Per Position</u>	<u>Other Requirements</u>
Elmwood	\$100.00	May purchase single positions
East Elmwood	\$100.00	May purchase single positions
East	\$125.00	May purchase single positions
East Chippewa	\$125.00	May purchase single positions
Oak Grove	\$125.00	May purchase single positions
North #1	\$175.00	May purchase single positions
North #2	\$175.00	May purchase single positions
Sanders #1	\$225.00	Must purchase positions in pairs
Sanders #2	\$250.00	Must purchase positions in pairs

The location of the specific position desired shall determine its relative cost. The City Clerk shall not sell irregular grave positions if he/she determines that such a sale would be detrimental to the overall development or appearance of the Cemetery or if such a sale would adversely affect adjoining positions. A schedule of costs shall be available for inspection at the City Clerk's office at all times. The City Clerk shall have the responsibility to see that all positions are sold at the price and according to the terms set by the Governing Body.”

SECTION 2. That a new Section 125.035. Cremation Burial Regulations, in Chapter 125 Cemetery Provisions, of the Code of the City of Paola, Kansas, 2009, is hereby added and shall read as follows:

“Section 125.035. Cremation Burial Regulations.

The following regulations apply to all cremains buried in the Paola Cemetery.

- A. No more than two (2) individual cremains may be buried on any one position in the Paola Cemetery.
- B. On a position that a casket and vault has previously been buried, up to two (2) cremains may be buried on top of the vault on that position.
- C. Cremains buried in the Paola Cemetery must be buried in an urn. The urn must be durable and sufficient for burial or buried in a vault specifically designed for urns. Cardboard boxes or other containers that easily decompose are not allowed.
- D. Cremains may not be scattered or sprinkled on any position in the Paola Cemetery.”

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper pursuant to KSA 12-3001, et seq.
