

RESOLUTION 2008-006

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FEE SCHEDULE FOR CONTRACTORS DOING BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, CHAPTER 500: BUILDING CODES provides for certain fee schedules; and,

WHEREAS, Section 500.100 of the MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF PAOLA provides that the Governing Body may, from time to time, revise said fee schedules, and,

WHEREAS, the City Manager has submitted a proposed LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FEES schedule to the Governing Body attached hereto as Exhibit A, and,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing Body of the City of Paola, Kansas that said proposed LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FEES schedule, attached hereto as Exhibit A, be approved and adopted as of November 12, 2009 replacing the previous License and registration Fees schedule, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FEES schedule shall be available in the office of the City Clerk.

**LICENSE AND REGISTRATION FEES
Pursuant to Paola Municipal Code Section 500.100**

Class A General Contractor	\$125.00
Class B General Contractor	\$125.00
Class C Residential General Contractor.....	\$125.00
Electrical Contractor.....	\$125.00
Plumbing Contractor	\$125.00
Mechanical Contractor	\$125.00
Class F, Provisional License	The fee for a provisional license shall be as required for each class license
Class S, Special Trades Contractor	\$75.00
Re-instatement Fee	\$50.00
Early Renewal	\$25.00 CREDIT

For each additional license holder in the same license classification, a fee of \$50 will apply for the license fee. An application form and all applicable documentation shall be submitted.

For contractors holding multiple classifications of licenses, the first shall be at the full license amount, with additional licenses for same licensee being \$50 per license.

Faxed certificates of insurance will NOT be accepted. An original certificate of insurance shall be received prior to a license being issued.

When insurance coverage expires the license shall be considered to expire by limitation and notice will be sent to the license holder. The license will not be reinstated until an original certificate of insurance has been submitted and a reinstatement fee is paid.

Any construction permits that the license holder possesses shall be considered to be null and void when the holder of the license or one of the designated contractors on the construction project authorized by a construction permit has expired or when insurance coverage has lapsed.
