ORDINANCE NO. 3019

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 10-CUP-01

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS:

Section 1. CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT GRANTED. Pursuant to regulations set forth in the Paola Land Development Ordinance (LDO) permission is hereby granted for a bed and breakfast at property commonly known as 29360 W 311th Street as provided in Section 2.

Section 2. CONDITIONS AND STIPULATIONS. The conditional use permit granted in Section 1 above, in addition to full compliance with any general provisions of the LDO, is hereby made contingent upon the performance and observation of the following conditions, of which the violation will be a basis for revocation:

- 1) The owner/proprietor is required to occupy the residence.
- 2) The number of bedrooms used for Bed and Breakfast shall not exceed five (5).
- 3) Bed and Breakfast shall comply with County and State requirements/licenses as a food service or lodging facility.
- 4) Short-term overnight lodging shall be permitted. Monthly rentals or leasing shall be prohibited.
- 5) A one off-street parking space is required.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official City newspaper.
