

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-005

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A POLICY FOR WAIVING BUILDING PERMIT FEES FOR THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Paola, from time to time, receives requests to waive building permit fees; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Paola desires to establish a fair and uniform policy to consider these requests;

NOW THEREFORE, the Governing Body of the City of Paola hereby adopts the following Policy for Waiving Building Permit Fees:

**City of Paola, Kansas
Policy for Waiving Building Permit Fees**

The City of Paola may, upon the approval of the Governing Body, provide for the waiver of building permit fees as follows:

- A. Waivers will be considered for the following applicants only:
 - 1) Entities that have statutory authority to levy local property taxes (these entities shall not include the State of Kansas or the U.S. Federal Government).
 - 2) Entities that are primarily funded by entities that have statutory authority to levy local property taxes.
 - 3) Individual projects for public recreation facilities that are not located on property owned by the City of Paola.
- B. Fees that will be waived include the fee for the building permit only. Other fees such as plan review fees may not be waived.
- C. To obtain a waiver of any building permit fee, qualifying applicants must provide the following at the time that the building permit is applied for:
 - 1) A written request to waive the building permit fee.
 - 2) Pay all other associated fees in connection with the building permit.
 - 3) Documentation that the applicant is primarily funded by an entity that has statutory authority to levy local property taxes (if requested).
- D. Requests to waive building permit fees from applicants not included in Paragraph A above will not be considered.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the City of Paola, Kansas, does hereby adopt the aforementioned Policy for Waiving Building Permit Fees as an Official Policy of the City.
