

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-006**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MIAMI COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Miami County, Kansas recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

**WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

**WHEREAS**, an adopted Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple FEMA pre-disaster and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Paola, Kansas participated in the FEMA-prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, from the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VII, have reviewed and approved the plan (January 28, 2010) contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governments and entities; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Paola, Kansas adopts the “*Miami County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan*” as an official plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Miami County will submit this Adoption Resolution to the California Office of Emergency Services and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region IX officials to enable the Plan’s final approval.
