

ORDINANCE NO. 3154

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR FIRE INCIDENT REPORTS UNDER THE KANSAS OPEN RECORDS ACT PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 45-220.

WHEREAS, the Paola Fire Department receives requests for fire incident reports. Due the department being volunteer, there are no regular business hours for staff to fill those requests. Staff is paid to comply with the request which often times require research. Currently there is no fee for this service to reimburse the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PAOLA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The Paola Fire Department will charge \$10.00 per report copy to reimburse the City for routine costs of retrieving records which are requested with specificity and are held within the department's current system.

SECTION 2. Any and all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication in the official city newspaper.
