**City of Paola RESIDENTIAL pickup ONLY.**  
Violators will be fined. **All items must be CURBSIDE (NOT IN THE ALLEY) by 7:00 a.m. Saturday, April 12th - ITEMS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP AFTER THE 12th!** Please do not set out items earlier than April 5th.

#### **ITEMS TO BE PICKED UP:**

- **Tires** – Must be removed from rims. Limit 2 per residence. Automobile tires only.
- **Any items that can be lifted by two people.** Small items must be contained in clear bags or boxes.
- **Televisions, Computers, or other Electronic Devices.**

#### **ITEMS WITH SPECIAL PICKUP INSTRUCTIONS**

##### **White Goods, Scrap Iron & Metal –**

Refrigerators and freezers must be emptied out, doors removed, locked or steel banded and turned face down. Please keep these items separate from other items.

#### **ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:**

##### **Brush & Limbs and other yard waste.**

Please take yard waste only to the yard waste collection site at the Paola Public Works facility. Brush and tree limbs will be picked up on the regular monthly brush collection days

##### **Regular Household Garbage** – Please wait for your regular trash pickup at your regular location.

**No Hazardous Waste or Batteries will be picked up.** To dispose of paint, thinners, varnishes, pesticides and oils contact the Miami County Sanitary Landfill, (327th & Hospital Drive), 913-745-1912 to determine when they will accept these items at the Noxious Weed building.

**Absolutely NO demolition or construction materials will be picked up.** Do NOT mix these materials in with other items to be picked up! (carpet, decks, outbuildings or other demolition projects).
