



Paola Family Pool Rules

- The posted admittance fee must be paid by everyone entering the pool. Discounted coupon books are available at the pool and at City Hall. Season pass I.D. cards are available **ONLY** at City Hall. These applications **MUST** be done in person so picture I.D. can be made.
- Season pass **I.D. cards must be presented** for admittance to the pool.
- Children 7 and under must be accompanied by an **ADULT**.
- The Paola Family Pool may be closed at any time due to inclement weather, temperature below 72 degrees, or because of low attendance.
- Entry fee to the pool is ½ **price for the last hour** the pool is open to the public and **free for the last ½ hour** the pool is open to the public.
- We allow the use of soft foam type balls in the pool except in the deep end. Please use caution when using these balls around other guests.
- **Floatation devices including noodles are not allowed** with the exception of lifejackets, arm floaties and baby floats with leg holes. Children using approved floatation devices must have an adult within arms reach. No floatation devices of ANY kind are allowed on the slides or in the diving board areas.
- **No jewelry or sunglasses are allowed on the slides.**
- Children must **3' 6" tall** and be able to **swim to the side unassisted** to use the slides. Parents may not get into the splash down area at the bottom of the slides to help their children.
- Guests must be able to swim 25 yards unassisted to use the diving boards.
- There will be **no free swim in the diving well area.**
- All entries into the pool from the sides must be **feet first.**
- **No dunking, sitting on shoulders or rough play is allowed.**
- **No food** allowed in the pool.
- **Please obey all posted rules.**
- **Lifeguards have the final say.** Please respect their requests as they are trained to help maintain your safety. **Non-compliance to rules shall result in expulsion from the pool.** Length of expulsion depends on severity of offense.
- When lightning is detected, visually or by the lightning monitor, the pool manager will **immediately** clear the pool – without exception. Thirty (30) minutes after lightning is no longer detected, the pool manager will announce “all clear” and swimming will resume. **NO RAIN CHECKS** will be issued unless the pool closes.
