**Due to Heat Warnings, Residential Routes to Start Earlier Effective
Wednesday, July 17.**

6:00 a.m. Start Time for Remainder of July and August

- WHAT:** Waste Management of Kansas, Inc. residential routes for the Kansas City metropolitan area will begin at 6:00 a.m. due to the forecasted extreme heat, for the remainder of this month.
